Self-Contained Overnight Stayers

There will be limited self-contained overnight stay options available nearby the Value Motors Wellington Family Speedway for the New Zealand Stockcar Championship 2024-25.

Location

The location of this camping option will be at the Upper Hutt Pony Club, which is located opposite our main entry gate on Twins Lake Road, Upper Hutt. This is approximately a 500m walk to our venue pedestrian entry gate at Wellington Speedway.

Costs:

\$30 per night, per motorhome / campervan. This is to be paid upon booking via our online system. You must book before 1st January 2025, there will be *no* option for paying and booking on arrival. Paying via the online system reserves your space, following this we will confirm your booking via email once this has been approved by the club.

Vehicle Requirements:

NO TENTS ARE ALLOWED IN THIS AREA OR THE CAR PARK AREA.

Fully self-contained Motorhomes and Campervans only (no trailers).

This area is a carpark and NOT a camping ground.

This is NOT suitable for any racers needing to wash / fix their Stockcars.

The marked area is approximately 4m wide x up to 12m long.

Motorhomes and campervans must be parked as indicated in the image below, and fit within the marked areas provided.

Entry and Exiting:

Overnight stays are available from Thursday 16th January - Monday 19th January 2025.

All stayers must be vacated by 10am on Tuesday 20th January.

Please indicate on your application form the nights you'd like to stay. If this changes during your stay, please email info@wellingtonspeedway.co.nz to approve these changes.

The site will also be used for car parking on race nights, which will be based around the entry and exit gate that you will come through. As the surface of the venue is grass, it is recommended that you do not exit and reenter multiple times throughout your stay. This will help to prevent the grass from going soft and creating issues with vehicles getting stuck if we have had rain prior to the weekend.

All entry into the Wellington Speedway venue will be as advertised for public.

Rubbish:

There are NO rubbish facilities provided and all rubbish is to be disposed of off-site.

There are NO glass bottles allowed on-site and all glassware must remain inside the motorhome / campervan. This is a non-negotiable requirement from the Pony Club due to the site being used permanently for horses.

There is to be no dumping of rubbish whatsoever.

There is to be no dumping of any water waste whatsoever into the facility.

Anyone identified as breaching these requirements will be trespassed from the property and Wellington Speedway.

Behaviour:

The availability of overnight staying is at the discretion of the club (Wellington Speedway and the Upper Hutt Pony Club). Abusing any representative of the club (Wellington Speedway and Upper Hutt Pony Club), causing a disturbance, wilfully damaging the property or other unacceptable behaviour will result in the offending party or party's being evicted and/or banned from further over-night staying and/or trespassed from both properties. The offending party will be liable to pay for any damages to the property, and will not be eligible for any refunds, even if they did not stay for their full paid stay. The club reserves the right to withdraw overnight staying at the venue both inside and out, for race meetings, without notice.

Liability:

The Wellington Speedway or Upper Hutt Pony Club will not accept any liability to any property owner, person or member in the motorhome or campervan for any accident, injury, loss or damage to persons or property occupying or using any part of the site however caused.

Application to Stay:

All overnight stayers must apply and pay via our online form.

Wellington Speedway has the right to refuse any party in staying.

Once your application has been submitted, you will get an email reply notifying you of your approval of the booking. This will not be confirmed until we have received full payment.

Registrations and full payment must be made by 1st January 2025.

There are very limited spots available, so we encourage you to apply early to confirm your place.

Arrival:

Prior to arrival, following your confirmation of registration, you will receive an email with details regarding the weekend and this will include a sitemap with your allocated spot on it. It is important that this map is strictly adhered to to save confusion for stayers arriving later. There will be allocated times where we will have a representative from Wellington Speedway onsite, if you arrive during these times they will guide you to your allocated park. We will be running a sticker system which will be a sticker per night of your stay, which must be displayed clearly on the drivers side of your front windscreen. This will be given to you on entry as we check that your vehicle is self-contained. If you arrive outside of the allocated times with our representative present, the gate will be closed and you will only be able to enter when they next arrive. Allocated arrival times will be supplied via email closer to the date.

Departure:

On departure, please make sure that you leave your site how you found it. As stated above, all waste and rubbish must be taken off-site with you. If you are leaving between 9pm - 8am please be courteous of those overnight stayers around you.
